Dear Parents/Guardians and Staff,

I am writing to update you on the progress of repairing the water line. It has taken the better part of two days, but the location of the leak has been determined. Crews will be on site working to repair the leak during the remainder of the day today, weather permitting, with the expectation that the repairs will be completed sometime during the day on Friday. In the mean time, all classrooms, offices and the kitchen will continue to be provided with bottled water for use by the students, faculty and staff. Parents should still feel free to send in their own bottled water with students if they so desire. The contingency plan for the use of bathroom facilities by grades 3, 5 and 6 has been working smoothly and will continue until such time as the water is restored to all three of those building. With a little luck, that may occur tomorrow. In any event, we fully expect that the system will be chlorinated, flushed, tested and cleared for use by the Health Department. Normal operating procedures and full use of all systems should greet students upon their return from the February break.
