## Alcohol, Tobacco, and Drug-Free Workplace

## **Purpose**

The Bethany Board of Education (Board) is concerned with the importance of maintaining a safe and healthy working and learning environment for all staff and students.

The Board directs the Superintendent to promulgate administrative regulations in furtherance of this policy.

All employees must abide by the terms of this policy and administrative regulation as a condition of employment. This policy and administrative regulation are adopted in accordance with state law and the Drug-Free Workplace Act.
