

Transportation

The Bethany Board of Education (Board) will provide appropriate transportation for students under provisions of state law and regulations. In determining the provision of transportation, the Superintendent shall administer the operation so as to:

1. provide for the safety of students, including consideration of hazardous conditions whether or not described in the accompanying regulations;
2. provide for appropriate supervision for students while on school transportation, consistent with the Board's Student Discipline Policy; and
3. assist disabled students by providing appropriate specialized transportation when required by law.

The Board directs the Superintendent to promulgate Administrative Regulations in furtherance of this policy.
