The Board expects the Superintendent, and other administrators, to understand and practice effectively and efficiently:

- 1. Decision-making and communication;
- 2. Planning, organizing, implementation, and evaluation of programs and personnel;
- 3. Coordination between the District and community to work cooperatively on behalf of local education.

The Superintendent is encouraged to conduct the operations of the District according to the management team concept.
