Bethany Public School District Sunscreen Use Parent/Guardian Form

Public Act 19-60 allows school students, six years of age or older, to possess and self-apply an over the counter sunscreen product while in school prior to engaging in any outdoor activity, provided a written authorization is signed by the student's parent/guardian and is submitted to the school nurse.

The sunscreen must be non-aerosol and must be approved by the Federal Drug Administration (FDA) for over the counter use for purposes of limiting ultraviolet light-inducting sun damage.

The Board adopted Policy and Administrative Regulation 5141.211 pertaining to this new legislation.

As a parent/guardian, I attest to the following:

- My child has demonstrated to me that he/she is capable of self-applying the non-aerosol sunscreen product.
- I understand that I am responsible to provide the non-aerosol sunscreen product for school use, clearly marked with my child's name and replenished as needed.
- I understand that the Bethany Public School District is not responsible for ensuring that the sunscreen product is applied to my child.
- I understand that my child is not to share his/her sunscreen product with other students.
- I recognize that school personnel are not expected to assist my child in the application of sunscreen.
- I understand that the school may revoke or restrict the possession, application, and use of sunscreen by my child if my child fails to comply with school rules related to the sunscreen product or if my child shows an unwillingness or inability to safeguard the non-aerosol sunscreen product from access by other students.
