

Food Service Finances

According to law and the regulations of the State Department of Education, student lunch costs shall be set at levels which support the school lunch program.

Meals for Needy Students

Meals for needy students shall be an expense charged to the School Lunch Program.

Participation in the National School Lunch Program

Participation in the National School Lunch Program is herewith authorized. Authorization is granted to the Superintendent to act on behalf of the Board of Education for purposes of participating in the National School Lunch Program.

Food Storage Provisions

Storage of food and supplies shall prevent waste, spoilage, pilferage, and the issuance of food and supplies shall be restricted to the purposes of the school food service only.

Approval of Menu Prices

Prices of all items on the menu shall be submitted to the Board of Education for its approval, as changes are needed. Revenues from lunchroom sales should offset the costs, which are to be borne by the food service program.

Monthly Financial Report

A financial report, current and accumulative, of the operation of the food service program shall be presented monthly to the Superintendent or his/her designee. A complete audit of the operation of the food service program shall be performed annually in accordance with legal requirements and Board Policy on Periodic Audits.
