

Transportation

The Bethany Board of Education will provide appropriate transportation for students enrolled in the Bethany Public School District under provisions of state law and regulations. The Superintendent shall be responsible for the school transportation system and shall develop and administer it to:

1. Provide maximum safety of students.
2. Supplement and reinforce desirable student behavior patterns.
3. Assist handicapped students appropriately.
4. Enrich the instructional program through carefully planned field trips recommended by the staff.

The transportation system shall be planned and operated in compliance with the General Statutes of the State of Connecticut and all regulations of the State Department of Education and the State Department of Motor Vehicles regarding the operation of school buses and motor vehicles.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent or his/her designee to manage and supervise the school transportation service and develop procedures and Administrative Regulations in furtherance of this policy.
