

Home Schooling

Parents wishing to educate children in the home may do so in compliance with Connecticut General Statutes and regulations of the Connecticut State Board of Education. When parents/guardians are willing to discuss their decision for equivalent education at home, District employees shall not criticize their choices.

The Board believes that formal education in public schools is highly beneficial both for the child and for society.

Children educated at home are considered to be non-public school students and are not part of the system's educational responsibility and are not part of the Bethany Public School District.

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to contact the Office of the Superintendent stating their intent to home school their child.
