

Placement of Special Education Students (Out-of-District)

In accordance with Connecticut law, when proper placement in local schools is not possible, the Bethany Public School District will provide financial support and transportation for students with disabilities to attend approved out-of-district special education programs.

Placement of students with disabilities in out-of-district special education programs that, according to state and/or federal law, require financial support from the Bethany Public School District will be based upon the student's individualized education plans (IEP's). The specific placement will be recommended by the Planning and Placement Team (PPT) in consultation with the Director of Special Services, parent(s)/guardian(s), and District and/or non-District diagnosticians.

The Superintendent shall provide the Board of Education with a monthly report on the number of students placed outside the District.

The Board of Education, if it has entered into an agreement pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 10-76d with a provider of special education services, shall submit to an audit conducted by the Auditors of Public Accounts for the purposes of examining the Board's monitoring of student attendance at such provider of special education services to ensure that proper services are being provided and costs are controlled. The Board will provide access to all records and accounts necessary to said auditors for purposes of conducting the audit.
