

Retirement of Buildings

Buildings operated by the school District may be retired from use when the Board of Education determines they are no longer educationally useful to the District and/or are unsuitable to current or projected school District needs. The Board of Education Facilities Committee ("Facilities Committee") shall consider facility closing. The plan shall require examination of remodeling possibilities or other uses for the facilities.

Because building closures are sensitive community issues, the Board of Education will appoint a committee representing a cross-section of the District and community to study and recommend alternatives for Board consideration - including facilities retirement, continued school District educational use, possibilities for remodeling and refurbishing, alternative uses, and other recommendations the committee chooses to make.
