

Selection of Site

School sites should be located as close as possible to the center of the attendance area the school will serve. The school shall be located so as to facilitate joint use of the sites and adjacent parks, playgrounds and open space by both the school and the town.

In recommending sites for school facilities, the following factors should be considered:

- Size
- Location
- Drainage and soil conditions
- Topography and elevation
- Accessibility
- Cost (including development costs)

This should be done in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes.
